They will extend their learning to find out about the standard system of classification, first developed by Carl Linnaeus and will learn about micro-organisms.</p>
<p>RE <u>Understanding Christianity- Creation & Fall</u> The children will look in detail at the story of Creation, using images and extracts from the Bible: Creation - Genesis 1-2 & Fall - Genesis 3. They will consider whether or not the story of Creation is conflicting or complimentary with scientific theories.</p>	<p>History Term 1 Key events and questions about <u>World War 1</u></p> <p>Geography Term 2 <u>Why is Fair Trade fair?</u> This is an enquiry-based unit, looking at what international trade involves and the idea of Fair Trade.</p>	<p>Computing Video production Recording, editing, and using different video techniques.</p> <p>Computing Flat-file databases</p> <p>This unit looks at how a flat-file database can be used to organise data in records. The children will use tools within a database to order and answer questions about data and will create graphs and charts from their data to help solve problems.</p>
