

Your child may be eligible for funded childcare.

Working parent entitlements: Apply online at www.gov.uk/apply-free-childcare-if-youre-working If eligible, you will be given an 11 digit code to give to your childcare provider. Working parents must renew their eligibility every three months to continue accessing their entitlements. Up to 30 hours is available from the term after your child reaches 9 months until school age.

Early Learning for Two Year Olds (EL2) for families in receipt of additional government support: Apply online: www.lincolnshire.gov.uk/parentportal. If eligible, you will be given a 6 digit code to give to your childcare provider. Up to 15 hours available from the term after their 2nd birthday.

3 & 4 year old universal funded childcare: No eligibility code is required. Speak to your chosen childcare provider. Up to 15 hours available to ALL children from the term after their 3rd birthday.

You may also be able to use Tax-Free Childcare or Universal Credit to support you with any costs.
