#### PUPIL PROGRESS BOOKLETS

These will be distributed to all families this week. Children who are on track to achieve the end of year expectations for their age group will have achieved 83.3% by the end of term 5. We are assuming that children who reach the end of year expectations will achieve 100% by the end of the year. There is currently only one year of data to match outcomes of teacher assessment to the end of key stage SATs results. The number of children involved was too small to reach any firm conclusions. We will review the 100% expectation when the second set of data is available in July.

#### SCHOOL TRIP

We are delighted to announce that we have booked a school trip for later in the term. This will be for the whole school to visit The Space Centre at Leicester. We have received a generous donation and secured a science grant which will considerably reduce the cost per child. Unfortunately, there is still a short fall and families will be asked to make a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the trip. No child will be discriminated against, but the school does not have an endless amount of funding to subsidise trips. If there are not sufficient funds raised through voluntary donations then the future of school trips will have to be reviewed. Full details of the trip and the voluntary donation will be sent home by the end of the week.
