ADOPT A BOOK FOR SCHOOL

When we were training last week, we were reminded that in addition to good teaching, a great book is the best way to demonstrate to children how particular aspects of grammar and punctuation can be used to engage the reader. Teachers have been buying some of the books voluntarily, but the new list of recommended titles would cost in the region of £850.00 – we are estimating each book at £10.00 at this stage - which is too much to expect.

We are producing the full list of titles with the price and the aspect of grammar and punctuation that they promote and will be inviting families to purchase a book, read it as a family and then donate it to school.
