The new tests were challenging and made children really think hard about what they have learned. All the children did their best. There is now a long wait for everyone until July when the results are published. Some children in Year 2 will be taking tests in May, but we work hard to try and make these seem just like a part of usual learning. They are not taken in the hall, for example, and when all the tests have been taken we are able to mark them ourselves. In June, the Standards and Testing Agency will publish conversion tables which will allow us to see if children have met the required standard. The outcomes are used as evidence alongside the children's books to inform teacher assessments.
