PUPIL PROGRESS BOOKLETS

These will be sent home this week. Children who have started school in Term 3 will find that there is a limited amount of information available but this will increase as the children spend more time in school.

Attendance for the Pupil Progress Booklets is calculated for each term independently. This encourages every child to try and achieve 100% because any absences in the previous term are not counted. This strategy is very successful as children have been proud to achieve 100% after a term with absences.

In all other circumstances, absence is counted over a longer period, referring back to the beginning of the school year. This means that holidays continue to have an impact long after they have been taken. If it can be shown that absence has been caused by illness then this is an authorised reason to be away from school.
