Spring Term	<p><u>Printing</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make art from observations, their environment, photographs then translate them in new materials • Use sketchbooks to practice and try out ideas and techniques • Use printing blocks to create artwork related to topics and themes and to explore pattern. • Use simple motif printing blocks to create and print more complex patterns- tessellating and interlocking. • Explore pattern print of wallpaper • Make choices and decisions about their art
Summer Term	<p><u>Drawing & Painting (Plants & wildlife)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Control drawing media to create light and dark tones • Control shading with a range of medias to describe form, light and shade • Practice drawing quick lines and more deliberate lines to sketch and draw • Use a range of pencils, crayons, chalks, felt pens, drawing pens and ink and biro and choose the suitable media for the purpose • Draw things they see from observation – nature, photos, still life • Develop painting skills with more control and precision painting lines and edges • Have experience using different types of paint. Know the properties of these • Know that all colours have dark and light values and how to make colours lighter and darker
