

## Languages LKS2

Throughout the year the children will cover a variety of aspects of the languages curriculum to ensure all children:

- understand and respond to spoken and written language from a variety of authentic sources
- speak with increasing confidence, fluency and spontaneity, finding ways of communicating what they want to say, including through discussion and asking questions, and continually improving the accuracy of their pronunciation and intonation
- can write at varying length, for different purposes and audiences, using the variety of grammatical structures that they have learnt
- discover and develop an appreciation of a range of writing in the language studied.

<b>Autumn Term</b>	<p><u>Moi (All about me)</u>            The aim this half term is to introduce simple French phrases and greetings. Through this topic children will learn numbers 1-10. Some of the core language is Bonjour! Salut! Au revoir!</p>
<b>Spring Term</b>	<p><u>Jeux et chansons (Games and Songs)</u>            Through this unit children will learn to count to 20 and start talking about their favourite games. Some of the core language is Combien de ...? J'ai...</p>
<b>Summer Term</b>	<p><u>On fait la fete (Celebrations)</u>            The purpose of this unit is for children to learn to talk about their achievements in games and activities. They also learn the names of the months, as well as a birthday greeting. Some of the core language is Bravo! Fantastique! Joyeux anniversaire!</p>
